Psalm 67 as a prayer
(also included on the back)

Mon| *James 1:27* – Pray for hearts that break for what breaks God's heart.


Tues| *1 Cor 13* – Pray for love at home, in Church, and at work that others would see God at work in us.

Wed| *Hosea 12:6; Amos 5:24; Rom 12:19; Heb 10:30* – Pray that God would bring justice, that shalom would emerge now.

Thurs| *1 Cor 15:54-58* – Pray that we all would be strengthened to continue working for the kingdom by the future hope we have, pray that the kingdom would come quickly.

Fri| *Eph 4:1-6* – Pray for unity in the body of Christ and the continuing process of sanctification.

Sat| *Micah 6:6-8* – Pray that we would not make a "god" in our own image that can be pleased by works or sacrifices but that we would instead act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with the LORD.
